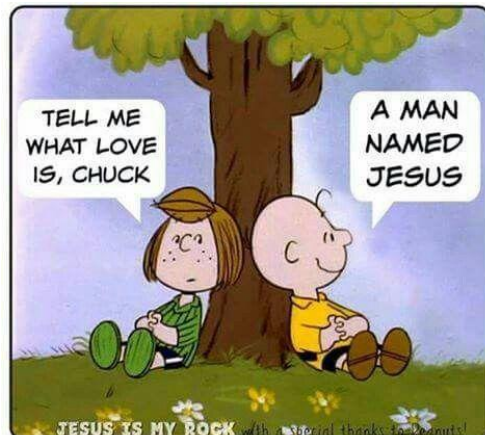

**I asked for all things that I might enjoy life. And God said "No".**

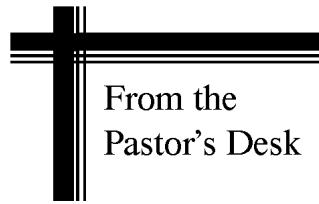
He said He will give me life, that I may enjoy all things.

*We're still planning on the parish hall being completed by the end of this month. Much has to happen still in order for that to be a reality, but things are moving along. Many details have to work in concert, which is keeping the people on the Parish Hall Expansion Committee busy right now.*

*We assumed responsibility for certain things like the cabinets, the flooring, the lighting, but that saves us a little money.*

*It looks like the inaugural event we'll have in our parish hall will be our first fish fry. Ash Wednesday falls on March 6 this year and we have the fish fries on the first, third and fifth Fridays of Lent this year, so our first fish fry will be on March 8. We are planning to have a kickoff though on Sat., March 16, after the 4:30 pm mass. We plan to have a steak dinner, allow everyone to see the renovated hall, perhaps demonstrate some of its features, and bless it. We'll soon make tickets for this event available in church. There won't be a charge for the tickets but we need to get an idea of how much food to prepare.*

*Next weekend, February 16-17, I will offer the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick for those who wish to receive it.*

*As I mentioned, Ash Wednesday is March 6, which is only about a month away. Ready or not, it is time to begin to give some thought and prayer to where we are in our relationship with the Lord and what might help us to draw closer to Him. Having reflected upon that, we then choose some practice we will undertake during Lent that will help us. We'll also soon be putting a basket out in church to collect your palms from last year. Recall that the ashes we use on Ash Wednesday come from burning blessed palms.*
