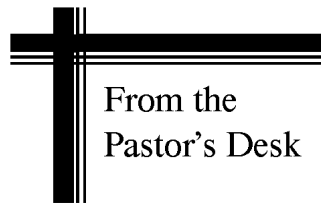

Pastor’s Desk

It has been a scramble of late to get the last details of the parish hall renovation done. It is all coming together but it doesn’t look like it will be done by the end of February. In fact, I don’t think the hall will be ready for our first fish fry on March 8. We will have to have it in the Knights of Columbus Hall. As I mentioned a couple of weeks ago, we’ve been planning on having a kickoff event after the 4:30 pm mass on March 16, but I’m not certain that we’ll be able to have it on that date. We’ll see what happens... and if we need to reschedule the kickoff, we will. Stay tuned...

One of the main delays right now with the renovation are the counter tops in the kitchen and serving room. The company we’re getting them from was having trouble getting here to measure. They’re now measured and ordered. It will take 2 or so weeks to get the counter tops, then the company will have to cut them and install them. There are some other minor issues to be taken care of also, plus we have to get all of our stuff out of storage and get it moved back into the parish hall. We’re getting there...

There will be a basket in the back of church beginning this weekend for you to put your old palms. They will be burned at some point and the ashes will be used for a future Ash Wednesday.

Lent isn’t too far around the corner. It’s not too early to begin to think of what practice we want to undertake during Lent to improve our relationship with the Lord. So, we examine our relationship with him to see what would help us draw closer at the present time and then do something to help us down that path.
