From the Pastor's Desk:

The preliminary word I've received is that we received about \$180,000 in pledges from our Commitment Weekend last weekend.

That amount should put us over the \$2 million mark. Other than wrapping up a few loose ends, and allowing those who were gone last weekend to fill out a pledge card this weekend, that wraps up the capital campaign.

I want to thank all of you who pledged, who gave your time as volunteers, and those who prayed for us. The money we raised puts a substantial dent in the debt we owe on the building.

We have seven young people who have been preparing for Confirmation. Some of them have been receiving that preparation at John Paul II School and some of them in parish faith formation. They will be joining several other youth from St. Peter, Sacred Heart and St. Ann for Confirmation on March 13. Bishop Medley will preside at the ceremony at Sacred Heart that evening at 6:00 pm. Pray for these young people as they prepare to take this big step in their faith life.

We also have fourteen 2nd graders who are preparing to make their First Communion in April. Recently, they celebrated the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time. Keep these youngsters in your prayers as well.

Finally, please also pray for Abriel and Hannah Bennett as they continue to prepare to join us in our Catholic faith at the Easter Vigil. We will be celebrating the Scrutinies with them on the 3rd, 4th and 5th Sundays of Lent at the 8:00 am mass.
