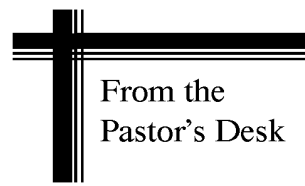

Pastor's Desk

*As we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord this weekend, we close the Christmas Season. All the trees, lights, the manger and greenery all have to come down and be stored for another year. If you can help with this after the 10:00 am mass, it would be greatly appreciated. After this weekend, we go into a stretch of Ordinary Time that will last until Lent.*

*We can see something of how the Liturgical Year works. We just celebrated the birth of Jesus at Christmas, then that he was raised in a human family as we celebrated Holy Family, and the visit of the magi at Epiphany. Now we end Christmas Season with the Baptism of the Lord, which took place at the very beginning of Jesus' public ministry. In the short stretch of Ordinary Time we will now enter, we will hear stories from the early part of Jesus' ministry. So there is a certain chronology to the Liturgical Year as we hear the story of the mystery of our salvation through Jesus.*

*On another final Christmas note, I want to thank everyone who made a contribution to the gift the parish gave me for Christmas. It was very generous of you! I feel so blessed to be pastor at St. Agnes. It is a pleasure to be here with good people like you.*

*The latest on the parish hall is all the drywall is hung and it is being mudded. Painting may begin next week. It looks like all but one strip is finished on the roof and I'm told that the exterior doors may go in next week. Things continue to move along.*

*Finally, next week is the annual Presbyteral Convocation. This is when Bishop Medley convokes all the priests of the Diocese to a four day formation meeting. There is a presenter each year that speaks about a particular topic. It also gives us priests time to be with one another and for Bishop Medley to address all of us on whatever matters he believes are important. So, there won't be daily mass in the parish except for Friday and no school mass next week.*

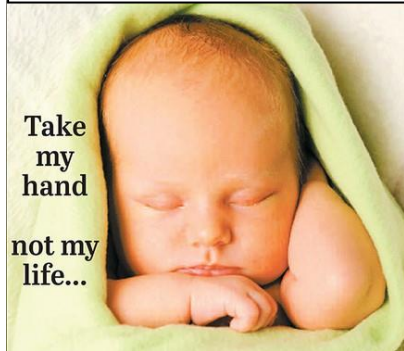
