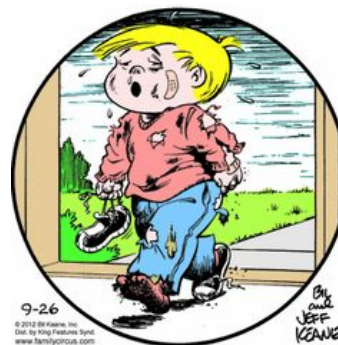

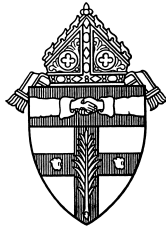

From the Pastor's Desk

You may recall that we discontinued filling out a ministry sign up sheet every year. What that means though is it is up to you to tell us if you want to begin a ministry and when you want to quit doing a ministry. We're happy to add or take you off of the list for any particular ministry, but now you must call the parish office to let us know.

Don't forget that I'll be offering the Sacrament Of the Anointing of the Sick during masses next weekend. I try to do this a couple of times each year so that those who need the sacrament but might not otherwise receive it can be anointed.

We took a vacation from Vacation Bible School last summer because the parish hall was being renovated, but we'll be having Vacation Bible School this summer. It will be July 15 - 17 from 5:00 - 7:00 pm. It is open for all children ages K - 5. I hope you will bring your children, it will be a lot of fun.

We're always looking for different and more effective ways to communicate with you. Some younger parents in our parish put us on to an app called 'Reminder.' Apparently this is used quite a bit by other organizations. So we're going to try to communicate things through this app as an additional means of getting the word out. We'll be using this to get information out about things like when Faith Formation begins, when it's called off because of weather, who's scheduled for liturgical ministries this weekend, just to name a few. If this gets a good response, I might even set up one of my own to communicate different kinds of things.

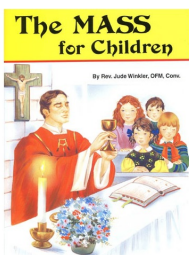
