




# From the Office:

Fr. Paul Reilly from the Missionaries of Africa will be doing the mission appeals at St. Agnes Parish on 7/27-28. Fr. Randy asked Fr. Reilly to write a little bit about what the congregation does for the church in Africa.

The Missionaries of Africa (also known as the "White Fathers") is an international Catholic missionary society of priests and brothers founded over 150 years ago in North Africa. Today the congregation has over 1,200 consecrated members and is active in 23 countries on the continent of Africa as well as in Europe, the Americas and Asia. Their missionary activities are concentrated on primary evangelization, parish ministry, youth development, social justice, peacebuilding and interfaith dialogue. Fr. Paul Reilly, M.Afr., will be giving mission appeals in our parish for funds towards the congregation's ministry in Ethiopia, where Fr. Paul has worked with disadvantage young people (orphans, street children, poor rural youth) for the past four years. Your generosity is great appreciated!


