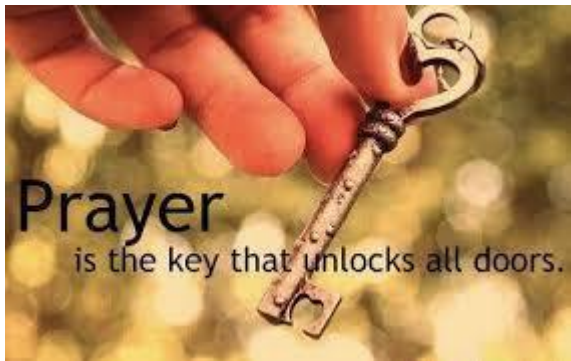

From the Pastor's Desk

New tables and chairs for the parish hall were ordered this past week. We ordered the Lifetime brand, which are made of durable plastic with metal frames. They're lighter and easier to handle than what we currently have and just as durable, if not more. We don't have a delivery date but I would guess it will be within two or three weeks.

We still don't have a firm date when plaster work will begin on the church ceiling. Wilkerson Plastering in Owensboro is going to do the job but they have been tied up doing stucco work on the new movie theater there. I understand they're now finished with that job and can now turn their attention to other jobs. We are one of several jobs on their list and as soon as I know when they plan to begin work on our ceiling, I'll pass it on to you.

It turns out that Wilkerson also does acoustic work. I've asked them about looking at our parish hall to take corrective measures to knock down the echo. I'll keep you informed as things progress. Parish Council met this past Tuesday and one topic of discussion was the fees for renting our parish hall. After much deliberation, we decided to change the rates based on the size of the event for which the hall is rented. For registered members of the parish, the fee for events of 75 people or less will be \$100. In addition to that, we are required to make sure the event is covered by insurance. If the renter already has insurance that will cover the event, all we need is a copy of the proof of insurance. If the event is not covered, then coverage is available through Catholic Mutual for \$95. There is also a \$150 cleaning fee, however, this fee will be returned to the renter if they sufficiently clean the hall and the key is returned.

If the event is over 75 people, the rental fee for registered parishioners is \$200, plus the insurance, plus the refundable cleaning fee. A higher fee will be charged to those who are not parish members for events both under or over 75 people.

There are always divergent opinions and some disagreement on matters like parish hall rental. We're trying to set fees at rates that are fair to both the renter and the parish. It's hard to strike a happy medium.
