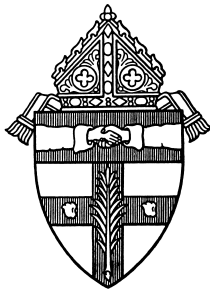

## *From the Pastor's Desk*

*We got a bit of a surprise this past week. We weren't expecting the new tables and chairs for the parish hall until July, but the freight company called and said they were ready to bring them. We got a crew together and unloaded them. There were a few discrepancies in what we received and what was ordered but we'll get that rectified. So, we have new tables and chairs.*

*We've also begun to work with a company in Owensboro to get the echo fixed. We'll look into other companies as well and go with who we think is the best option.*

*At the last parish council meeting, we looked at all the feedback you gave us regarding what you think we need to concentrate on as a parish over the next five years. Our youth is certainly a concern that was expressed. Charlie Hardesty, who is the director of youth ministry for our diocese has been working on some things for youth in our county. If you're interested in being involved, there will be a meeting on Monday, June 24, at 5:00 pm in our parish hall. Charlie is trying to organize a county-wide effort for youth ministry. As a result of his efforts, we won't be trying to do anything on the parish level right now so as to not compete with what he's doing. But we will begin having masses with youth performing the liturgical ministries. That will begin probably in August.*

*Activities for senior parish members was also something you indicated so we will begin organizing some things. The other area the parish council discussed beginning to try to do something with is adult faith formation.*

*We're going to go to work and we'll need your involvement. I hope you're ready to go to work also.*

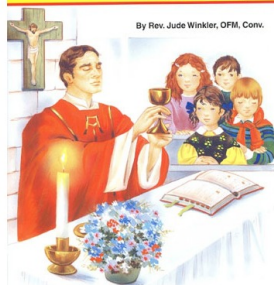
