LENT

Fasting Days: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting, where Catholics may eat only one full meal and two smaller meals that do not equal a full meal.

Abstinence: Catholics are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all Fridays during Lent.

Age Restrictions: The norms on fasting apply to Catholics aged 18 to 59.

Additional Practices: During Lent, many also choose to give up certain luxuries or engage in additional prayer and reflection as a form of penance. These practices are meant to foster spiritual growth and reflection during the Lenten season.
