Alex was baptized in another denomination but desires to join us in our Catholic faith at the Easter Vigil. She has been preparing to do so in RCIA and has engaged the process with sincerity, honesty and fervor. As I wrote last week, we celebrate with her the Rite of Sending this Sunday at the 10:00 a.m. mass. In this rite, we surround her with love and support and express our eagerness for her to join us in the celebration of the sacraments. Then at 2:00 pm on Sunday, Alex will join many others across our diocese who are also in RCIA at the celebration of the Rite of Election with Bishop Medley. Our role as a community of faith is to offer her support, prayer and welcome. Let's extend that to Alex as we celebrate this important step in her journey of faith.

Next Sunday we celebrate a penitential rite with Alex at the 10:00 am mass. That rite is a public recognition by Alex that there are areas of her life where she doesn't yet walk as closely with Jesus and her need for his mercy. It is also a reaffirming of her commitment to turn her life over to him and follow him more closely. Such a rite is a good reminder to all of us that we too have areas of our lives where we don't walk so closely with the Lord. We too are in need of his mercy. Let us all pray together and strive together to turn ourselves and our lives more fully over to him.

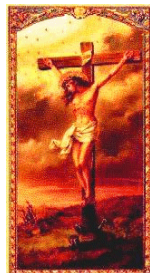
Every parish family is asked to bring a dessert for at least one fish fry. Those whose last name begins with:
