That leads us to the parish celebration of the re-opening of the parish hall... I certainly hope everything is done in time to have our celebration on March 30. If by chance it isn't, then we'll delay it again but things should be done by then. After all the construction work is completed, we'll still need to give the place a good cleaning and move our stored things back in. Help will be needed for both of those tasks.

Finally, Confirmation will be on Sunday, March 31, at the 10:00 am mass. Bishop Medley will be here to confirm seven 8th graders. They are: Elijah Baird, Layton Burgess, Emma Floyd, Jessica Luttrell, Tristan Moore, Madison Morris, and Aiden Schneider. Please pray for them and their families as they prepare to take this big step in their faith.

St. Agnes Parish Lenten Fish Fry



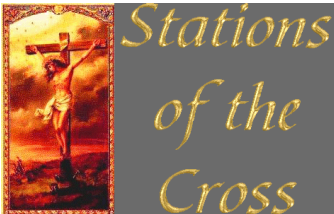

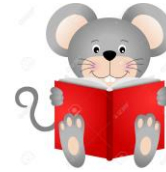
