Here's the latest update on our parish hall. We've been having an issue with water leaking in through the doors leading out to the patio. Much of that problem is the way the patio concrete has been poured. Water isn't draining away from the building the way it should. We asked the contractor to do it over, and they did pour part of the patio again, but it still isn't right. They're going to have to pour it again. As a result of the water issue not yet being resolved, the flooring people can't finish their work. There are a few other issues we're trying to get resolved but they are smaller ones. So, the bottom line is that when we have our celebration next Saturday after the 4:30 mass, the hall may not be 100% finished. The issues will get resolved, but perhaps not by the 30th.

I've decided to go ahead and have our celebration anyway. Everyone who is going to attend has been planning to do so and there isn't a good weekend in the near future in which to move it. We'll be getting into Spring Break, Palm Sunday, Easter, etc. So, 100% done or not, we're still moving forward with our plans for next Saturday.

Next Sunday, March 31, Bishop Medley will be with us for the celebration of Confirmation at the 10:00 am mass. As I've been writing, seven of our 8th graders will be confirmed this year. Please pray for them. Please also pray for Alex Russell who is in her final preparations to enter our faith at the Easter Vigil.
