*Many thanks to everyone who attended our town hall meeting last Wednesday. There were about 30 who came. Kevin Kauffeld and Tom Lilly did a wonderful job of leading us through a process of sorting through all the ideas submitted and prioritizing what we think is most important. I don't have the final results yet but Kevin and Tom said they would have them to us by our next parish council meeting, which is this coming Tuesday. We'll see where we go from here.*

*Summer is here, which usually means vacation, a break from school and outdoor activities. But that doesn't mean we take a vacation from our faith. There are Catholic churches at the lake, the river camp isn't very far away, and there are Catholic churches wherever ball games and tournaments may take us.*

*We have enough money left from donations to the Building Fund to go ahead and get new tables and chairs for our parish hall. I ordered them this past week but I don't know yet when they will arrive. We're getting the Lifetime brand, which are a durable plastic with metal frames. They're much lighter and easier to handle than what we currently have.*

*We'll also be looking into getting the echo in the parish hall corrected. We'll probably have to get some sound panels installed to absorb some of the sound. We're going to consult with some sound professionals to find out how many panels we need, where they need to be put, and what kind.*

*Finally, we celebrate Memorial Day on Monday. It is a time we recognize and give thanks for all the brave men and women who have given their lives in defense of our nation. May they rest in peace. Amen.*
